Maize biscuits are the **traditional biscuits of the province of Cuneo**: delicious rings made with wheat flour and “Meliga” maize flour, from an ancient type of Piedmontese maize, with grated lemon zest.

Every biscuit is **hand-made**, creating the characteristic round shape



Curious facts: Camillo Benso di Cavour's favourite sweet treat

It is said that Mr Cavour used to finish his meals with two maize biscuits and a glass of Barolo Chinato. Maize biscuits pair beautifully with a sweet wine like Moscato or sweet liqueur wines, such as Barolo Chinato and Moscato Passito.
